
SECTION VI - HEALTH HAZARD DATA

ROUTE(S) OF ENTRY: INHALATION? Yes SKIN? Yes INGESTION? Yes EYES? Yes

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF OVEREXPOSURE: Prolonged or repeated contact of concentrated product with skin and/or eyes may cause irritation and reddening. Ingestion may cause nausea, abdominal discomfort and diarrhea. Inhalation of high concentrations may cause respiratory irritation, dizziness, headache and general malaise.
